

Commission's decision. For the reasons set forth in the brief accompanying this Motion, the Commission respectfully requests the following:

1. That this cause be dismissed because Petitioners failed to raise the issue of, and to present evidence establishing, a personal pecuniary injury, and have therefore failed to establish standing pursuant to Indiana Code section 36-7-4-1603; and

2. That this cause be dismissed unless Petitioners show that they have suffered a personal pecuniary injury sufficient to establish standing pursuant to Indiana Code section 36-7-4-1603 and otherwise under Indiana law; and

3. That this cause be dismissed unless Petitioners post a bond in accordance with Indiana Code chapter 34-13-5, or as otherwise compelled by equitable considerations, to cover all damage and costs that accrue to Respondents by reason of the pendency of this cause; and

4. That, if this Court determines that Petitioners should be allowed to continue with the prosecution of this cause, that an expedited schedule be established such that this Court can render final decision within sixty (60) days of the date of this Motion.

The Commission respectfully requests that this cause be dismissed, or that this Court set a hearing as otherwise requested herein. Counsel for the Commission is available to participate electronically at the Court's earliest convenience.
